Cae Bodfach Working Group August 2026

A number of short-term actions have been identified for consideration for completion ASAP:

- removing the sculpture
- clearing willow and undergrowth around Wendy Evans's memorial tree
- tidying the pump track
- continuing installation of play equipment
- ordering benches and a shelter
- formalising an agreement with BRACE to manage the orchard and food garden
- improving access to the beach area
- establishing a volunteer register and risk-assessment system. Any volunteer work must comply with Town Council procedures, including risk assessments, public liability cover and registration systems.
- liaising with the junior football team about the offer of goalposts. There is a need to establish if there is a need or desire from the wider community for goalposts in the field.
- improved signage. Suggestions include short text supported by QR codes linking to detailed information online, bilingual signage, maps showing habitat zones, and explanations of the appearance of certain areas. The large sign currently at the main entrance could be relocated to the orchard and food garden, with a new sign created for the main field. Signage decisions should involve all relevant stakeholders, reflecting the field's purpose as a community asset.
